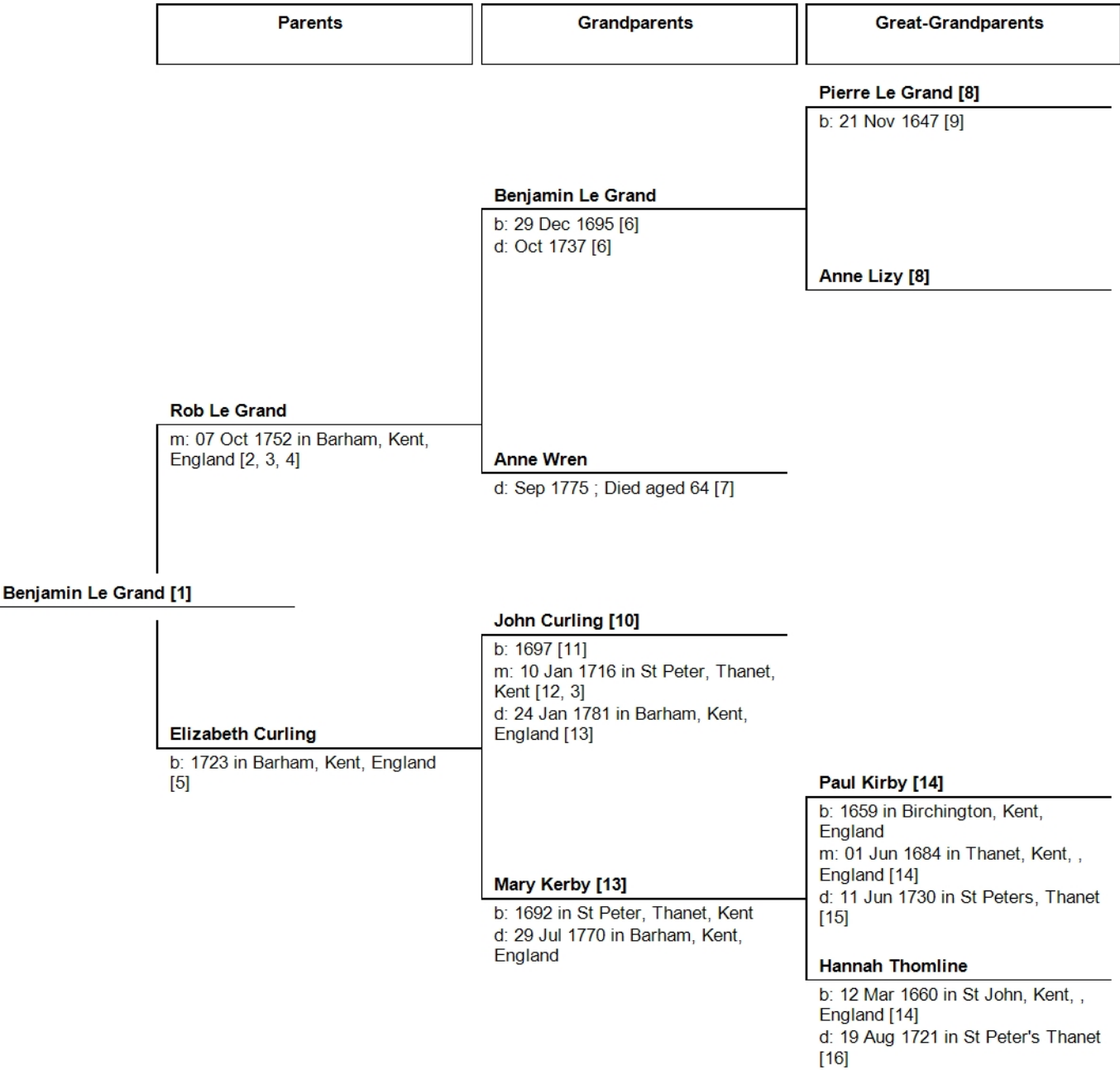
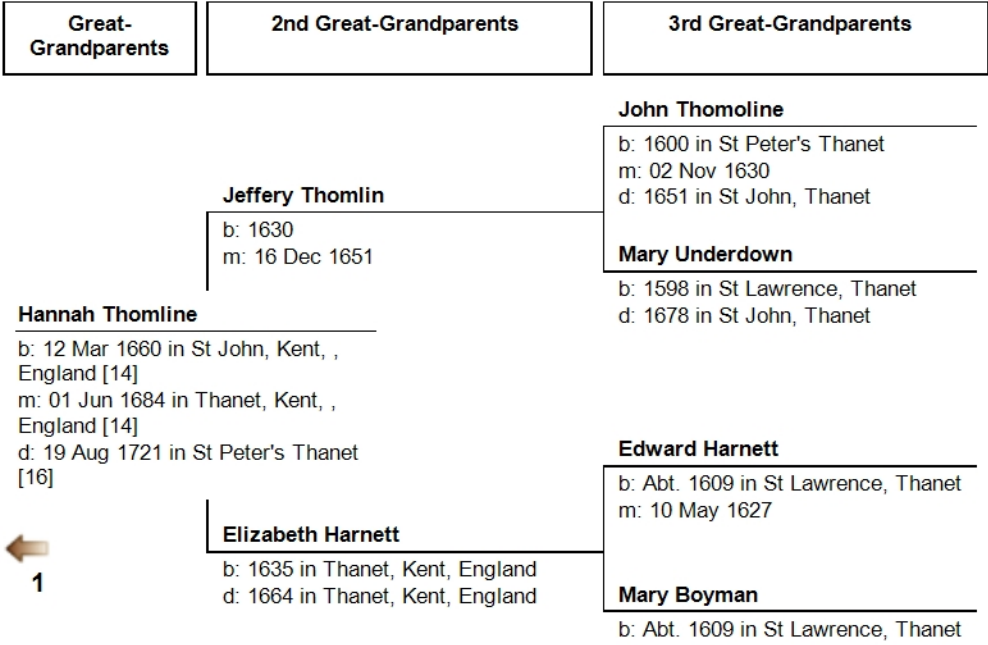


Pedigree Chart for Benjamin Le Grand

He married secondly on 7th May 1767 Anne Hayward, who died 15th March 1819, aged 84.
